APPLY FOR MAJORS IN FRANCE

procedure "HORS DAP"

2024 - 2025

The "Hors DAP" procedure targets students who wish to continue their studies starting from the second year of Bachelor (L2) up until Master 2 or for those aiming to integrate an Engineering School, Business School or Art School.









PREPARE YOUR APPLICATION

Choose your majors

The "hors DAP" procedure allows you to select up to 7 programs in fields related to your initial course.

Procedure Calendar

- Beginning of registrations: October 1, 2023
- Beginning of the appointments for the application fees payment and validation:
 October 9, 2023
- Closing date for registrations: January 31, 2024

DOCUMENTS

Prepare as early as possible the below documents, needed for the constitution of your online file :



- The transcripts of all the courses already achieved, year by year. All the transcripts must be translated to French or English;
- Letter of registration issued by your university if your are still studying;
- Certificate of success of a French language test or an English language test if you are applying for programs in English. If you have not taken the exam yet, provide proof that you have registered to an upcoming test;
- ID and photo.









YOUR APPLICATION STEP BY STEP



Constitute your online file

- Create your online file starting October 1st, 2023 on the platform "Études en France";
- Create an account by clicking on "Sign Up" "and fill the section "I am an applicant";
- In the section "I enter my personal data", upload a recent photo and an ID;
- In the section "My course", upload your baccalaureate diploma and the transcripts of all your university courses as well as any other diploma your have already achieved. All your documents must be translated to French or English;
- In the language section, upload the certificate of achievement of a French or English test. If you have not taken the exam yet, provide proof that you have registered to an upcoming test;
- In the section "I fill out my programs cart", select up to 7 majors. Always make sure to check the pre-requirements of each major and the possibility of a parallel procedure.

YOUR APPLICATION STEP BY STEP



Get your file validated by Campus France

Once your file is completed, you have to book a validation appointment via your "Etudes en France" account. Appointment slots will be available starting **October 9th, 2023** until **January 31th, 2024**. Click on "*I prepare the application*", submit your file then click on "*Book an appointment*".

The "Études en France" procedure's fees are **300€** to be paid in euros and in cash at the cashier of the Institut Français du Liban on the day of your validation appointment. These fees cover the treatment of your file, the transmission of the applications to the universities via the platform, the interview as well as your "Pre-consular certificate" delivered by Campus France and mandatory for a long stay visa request.



The Interview

After validation of your file, you will receive an invitation message for the interview by WhatsApp. This interview will take place online or at Campus France. Your file will be sent to the universities following the interview.



Your final choice

You will receive answers from the universities in the section "Answers of the Institutions". You will have to confirm your final choice in the section "I am accepted" before May 31th, 2024.





YOUR APPLICATION STEP BY STEP



Pre-consular certificate


Following confirmation of your final choice, you will have to go personally to Campus France office in Beirut to collect your pre-consular certificate, which is mandatory for the student visa application. The dates to collect the pre-consular certificate will be communicated to you later on.



Long stay student visa

You will have to apply for a student visa issued by the General Consulate of France in Beirut, by booking an appointment on the <u>TLS Contact website</u>. For more details about the different procedures, check the French Embassy in Lebanon or Campus France Liban's websites.
