APPLY FOR PROGRAMS IN FRANCE

"DAP BLANCHE" procedure

2026 - 2027

"DAP "stands for **Demande d'Admission Préalable**. This procedure targets students holding a lebanese baccalaureate or in preparation of a lebaneses baccalaureate and wishing to integrate:

• a first year of Bachelor in France (L1) (DAP Blanche procedure); please note that in France, first-year bachelor programs are offered in private institutions. It is rare for public institutions to offer a first-year program in English.







PREPARE YOUR APPLICATION

1) Choose your major

The DAP procedure allows you to apply for up to 3 university majors for the DAP Blanche procedure.

2) Follow the procedure calendar

- Beginning of registrations: October 1st, 2025
- Beginning of the appointments for the payment of the application fees and validation: October 8th, 2025
- Closing date for registrations: December 15th,
 2025

DOCUMENTS

Prepare as early as possible the below documents, needed for the constitution of your online file:



- Transcripts of the two first years of high school (Grade ten and eleven).
- Letter of registration to the last year of high school or the official baccalaureate diploma if already obtained.
- Certificate of success to an English language test. If you have not taken the exam
 yet, provide proof that you have registered to an upcoming test.
- ID and photo.





YOUR APPLICATION STEP BY STEP



Constitute your online file

- Create your online file starting October 1st, 2025 on the platform Études en France;
- Create an account by clicking on "Sign Up" "and fill the section "I am applicant";
- In the section "I enter my personal data", upload a recent photo and an ID;
- In the section "My course", upload in the section "year in high school" the transcripts of the
 two first years of high school and the current letter of registration issued by your high
 school. If you have already obtained you baccalaureate, upload the diploma in the section"
 High school diploma or equivalent". All your transcripts must be in French or English;
- In the language section, upload the certificate of achievement of an english test. If you have not taken the exam yet, provide proof that you have registered to an upcoming test;
- In the section "I fill out my programs cart", select "1ère année de licence" for university programs (up to 3 choices).

LANGUAGE CERTIFICATIONS

Check the language requirements on the institution's website. An english test is required (TOEFL, IELTS, SAT...), and if a french level is also required, you can contact the french institute by sending a mail at the following address: cdl.beyrouth@if-liban.com or visit the website: institutfrancais-liban.com

Get your file validated by Campus France

Once your file is completed, you have to book a validation appointment via your "Études en France" account. Appointment slots will be available starting **October 8th, 2025** until **December 15th, 2025**. Click on "*I prepare the application*", submit your file then click on "*Book an appointment*".

The "Études en France" procedure's fees are **320€** to be paid in euros and in cash at the cashier of the french institute of Lebanon on the day of your validation appointment. In case of an incomplete file, a new appointment will need to be arranged.

Pass the interview

After the validation of your application, it is mandatory to have an interview with the academic consultant of Campus France. This interview may take place online. Following this interview, your application will be submitted to the institutions. (forwarded)



Confirm your final choice

You will receive answers from the institutions in the section 'Answers from the institutions'. You must confirm your final choice in the 'I am accepted' section before **May 31st, 2026**.





YOUR APPLICATION STEP BY STEP



Pre-consular certificate

Following the confirmation of your final choice, you will have to go personally to Campus France office in Beirut to collect your pre-consular certificate, which is mandatory for the student visa application. The dates for withdrawing it will be communicated on our social media.



Your student visa

Once the pre-consular certificate is obtained, you can apply for the visa at the French Consulate General in Beirut. Make an appointment on the TLS Contact website.
